

**CHECKLIST: FAMILY MEMBERS OF EU OR EEA NATIONALS**  
**(Please, submit documents in this order)**

**SPOUSES, DESCENDANTS AND DEPENDENTS OF EU OR EEA NATIONALS WHO EXERCISE THEIR RIGHT OF FREE MOVEMENT WITHIN THE EU/EEA AREA MUST SUBMIT A NUMBER OF SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS:**

*Please check the boxes below and sign to confirm which documents you have submitted:*

- Passport photo** (*not older than 3 months, 2 inches in size, white background, with no glasses and glued to the application form.*)
- Passport or travel document.** *Please make sure that your passport is valid for at least three months beyond your intended stay in Norway, and that the passport has a blank page for a visa sticker.*
- Copy of the applicant's passport** (*Place and date of issue, expiration date, previous visas, valid resident/- work permit in Thailand etc.*)
- Marriage Certificate** - *If you are married to an EU or EEA citizen (original or certified true copy)*  
**Birth Certificate** - *If one or both of your parents are EU EEA citizens (original or certified true copy)*  
**The Birth Certificate of the son/ daughter you depend on** – *If you are a dependent ascendant of an EU or an EEA citizen (original or certified true copy)*
- Copy of the EU/ EEA national's passport**
- Visa application fee** – In order to avoid abuse of the Visa Portal, all applicants must 'pay' the appropriate fee when registering the application. However, when the Embassy receives the above-mentioned documents proving the relationship to the EU/ EEA national (spouses, descendants and dependants ascendants), the fee will be refunded immediately (electronically). Please note that the payment amount is only *reserved* on your account, not actually transferred to the Embassy. Once you produce the relevant supporting documents proving that you are exempt from paying the visa fee, the Embassy will cancel the fee authorisation immediately.  
Notwithstanding, if you do not produce the relevant documentation (as stated above) within 14 days after applying on the Portal, the fee will be transferred to the Embassy (payment provider default). A refund will still be made when producing the relevant documentation, but as the transfer has already taken place, it may take 2-3 weeks before the money is back on your account.
- It is not necessary to submit any other documents, although the Embassy **strongly** recommends that you always travel with a **valid health/ travel insurance**

**NOTE: E-mails, faxes and scanned documents are not accepted**

**IMPORTANT**

I hereby confirm that I personally have submitted this application for a visa and that all information stated in the application and the supporting documentation is true. I am aware that providing incorrect information or falsified documents deliberately are punishable acts by both Thai and Norwegian law and will lead to refusal of visa.
