

## **CHECKLIST: BUSINESS VISIT**

Please be informed that a joint electronic archive for the entire immigration administration will gradually replace the current paper archive. This means that all documents which are listed in the checklist below will be electronically scanned at the Embassy from January 2011. It is therefore very important that all original documents must be submitted with a perfect copy in A4 format. Please do not staple or glue any documents together as this will delay the scanning process.

	<b>Passport photo</b> (not older than 3 months, 2 inches in size, white background, with no glasses and glued to cover letter.)	the

	<b>Copy of the applicant's passport</b> ( <i>Place and date of issue, expiration date, previous visas, valid resident permit in Thailand etc</i> ). <i>Please make sure that your passport is valid for at least three months beyond your intended stay in Norway, and that the passport has at least two blank pages for a visa sticker.</i>	
	Booking of roundtrip air ticket, with fixed travel dates. (Do not buy the ticket until visa has been granted. Note: If the application is approved, the visa will be issued according to the dates on the booking).	
	<b>Original compulsory travel medical insurance</b> + $\frac{1 \text{ copy}}{1 \text{ copy}}$ (covering the entire Schengen area for a minimum at of $\in 30,000$ for the duration applied for (as per travel plan submitted).	mount
	Invitation from the business associate in Norway stating the purpose and length of the visit (this show original and written on company letterhead paper).	ıld be in
	Documentation about the applicant's company/enterprise/business (for example bank accounts) with confirmation from the company that the applicant is travelling in its behalf (this should be in original written on company letterhead paper).	
	<b>Documentation of the applicant's position in the company</b> (employment contract or confirmation from employer)	his/her
	Confirmation of accommodation in Norway (for example a hotel reservation)	
	<b>Letter granting Power of Attorney</b> (Optional for applicants who want another person to represent them case). Separate form is obtainable on the Embassy's website).	in the
